This course is co-organized with the Nethersole School of Nursing under Faculty of Medicine of The Chinese University of Hong Kong. It is designed to equip health and social care providers with essential knowledge and practical skills to conduct Advance Care Planning (ACP) within Chinese communities.

Grounded in evidence-based tools and strategies, the course offers both knowledge-based and skill-based training delivered by a multidisciplinary team of experts, including lawyers, medical doctors, nurses, and social workers. Participants will learn to navigate complex care decisions in serious illness contexts and communicate effectively with patients and families.

Medium of Instruction: Cantonese supplemented with English

Target Group: Health and social care practitioners
